SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 658
(As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING GARY
2 GRUBBS OF PRENTISS, MISSISSIPPI, FOR HIS PROLIFIC ACTING AND
3 SCRIPTWRITING CAREER, UPON THE OCCASION OF THE NEW STAGE THEATRE
4 PRODUCTION OF HIS PLAY "AS THE CROW FLIES".

5 WHEREAS, Gary Grubbs resigned from his job as a bulldozer
6 salesman in Prentiss, Mississippi, and in 1977 he and his wife,
7 Glenda, moved to Los Angeles from Mississippi to pursue careers in
8 the entertainment industry; and

9 WHEREAS, now some twenty years later Gary has worked for some
10 of the most distinguished directors of our time, in a number of
11 motion pictures including "JFK" (Oliver Stone), "Silkwood" (Mike
12 Nichols), and "Honkytonk Man" (Clint Eastwood), and this summer he
13 was featured in "X-Files The Movie" and can be seen in
14 "Astronaut's Wife" to be released next year; and

15 WHEREAS, on television, Grubbs initially made a name for
16 himself by portraying attorneys in two of the highest rated
17 programs in television history, "The Burning Bed" and "Fatal
18 Vision," and has appeared on "The X-Files," "Touched by an Angel,"
19 "JAG" and "ER," and currently Gary can be seen on the new "Will
20 and Grace" series for NBC; and

21 WHEREAS, "As the Crow Flies" is his first full-length play
22 and he is thrilled that The New Stage Theatre in Jackson,
23 Mississippi, is mounting this first production, and as a
24 screenwriter he has successfully sold scripts to CBS and the USA
25 networks; and

26 WHEREAS, Gary's family has quite a history of public service
27 in Mississippi: Gary's father was Sheriff of Jefferson Davis

28 County, his mother was Tax Assessor of Jefferson Davis County, his
29 brother, Demmery, was Mayor of Vicksburg, Mississippi, and no
30 stranger to the Legislature, and his beautiful wife, Glenda, was
31 selected as Miss Mississippi in 1972; and

32 WHEREAS, Gary and his wife are both graduates of the
33 University of Southern Mississippi and they have two children,
34 Molly and Logan; and

35 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this native
36 son whose success in the entertainment field brings honor to his
37 community and to the State of Mississippi:

38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MISSISSIPPI STATE
39 SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That we
40 do hereby commend and congratulate Gary Grubbs of Prentiss,
41 Mississippi, for his prolific acting and scriptwriting career upon
42 the occasion of The New Stage Theatre production of his new play
43 "As The Crow Flies," and we wish him and his family continued
44 success in their careers and other endeavors.
