SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 4

1 A RESOLUTION TO AMEND SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 38, 1998 REGULAR 2 SESSION TO EXPAND THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COASTAL STREAMS WATER 3 BASIN DISTRICT STUDY COMMITTEE TO INCLUDE THE SENATORS WHO 4 REPRESENT STONE, PEARL RIVER AND GEORGE COUNTIES; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI,
That Senate Resolution No. 38, 1998 Regular Session is amended as
follows:

A special study committee is created to make a comprehensive 9 study of the need for establishing a coastal streams water basin 10 district to provide for the conservation and beneficial use of 11 surface waters in the gulf coast region. The committee shall be 12 13 composed of six (6) members of the Senate who represent the three 14 (3) Mississippi Gulf Coast Counties and three (3) members of the Senate who represent Stone, Pearl River and George Counties to be 15 16 appointed by the Lieutenant Governor, and the Chairman of the Senate Ports and Marine Resources Committee who shall serve as 17 chairman of the committee. 18

Within fifteen (15) days after sine die adjournment of the 19 1998 Regular Session of the Legislature, the Lieutenant Governor 20 21 shall appoint the members of the committee. After the members are appointed, the committee shall meet on a date designated by the 2.2 23 chairman of the committee at the New Capitol, to organize the committee and establish rules for transacting its business and 24 keeping records. A majority of the members of the committee shall 25 constitute a quorum at all committee meetings. An affirmative 26 27 vote of a majority of the members present and voting shall be

S. R. No. 4 99\SS01\R544 PAGE 1 required in the adoption of rules, resolutions and reports, and in any other actions taken by the committee. All members of the committee shall be notified in writing of all regular and special meetings of the committee, which notices shall be mailed at least five (5) days before the dates of the meetings.

33 The committee may establish any subcommittees that it deems 34 desirable to study and report to the committee with respect to any 35 matter that is within the scope of this resolution.

The committee shall make a written report of its findings and recommendations, and shall mail copies of the report to each member of the Senate not later than December 1, 1999.

In carrying out the provisions of this resolution, the committee may utilize the services, facilities and personnel of all departments, agencies, offices and institutions of the state, including the state universities and the community and junior colleges.

For attending meetings of the committee, each member shall be 44 45 paid, from the Senate contingent expense fund per diem compensation in the amount authorized by Section 25-3-69, 46 47 Mississippi Code of 1972, and a mileage allowance and an expense allowance in the amount authorized by Section 5-1-47, Mississippi 48 49 Code of 1972. However, no per diem compensation, mileage allowance or expense allowance shall be paid for attending 50 meetings of the committee while the Legislature is in session, and 51 52 no per diem compensation, mileage allowance or expense allowance shall be paid without prior approval of the Senate Management 53 54 Committee.

All expenses incurred by and on behalf of the committee shall be paid from funds made available by the Senate Management Committee from the Senate Contingent Expense Fund, from any funds appropriated for the purpose of this resolution, and from any grants or contributions made to the committee for its purpose.

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
