SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 11

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE EXCHANGE CLUB OF BYRAM,
2 MISSISSIPPI, UPON ITS ONE-YEAR ANNIVERSARY AND FOR ITS DEDICATED
3 SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY.

4 WHEREAS, the Exchange Club of Byram, Mississippi, was
5 chartered on January 26, 1998, with 50 members, and thereupon,
6 elected Donna Arnold as charter President; and

7 WHEREAS, the Exchange is America's oldest service club and is
8 a progressive member organization which focuses on personal and
9 professional development, building a healthy society and aiding
10 America's communities; and

11 WHEREAS, the Exchange Club of Byram has four programs of
12 service to aid our communities: Americanism, Youth, Community
13 Service and Child Abuse Prevention; and

14 WHEREAS, the Exchange Club of Byram raised over \$14,000.00
15 from April through December 1998 to fund the club's various
16 community projects, such as Child Abuse Prevention Month,
17 GIVEAKIDAFILAGTOWAVE, various crime prevention programs and various
18 senior citizens programs; and

19 WHEREAS, every month the Exchange Club of Byram honors
20 students from area schools by recognizing them to receive the
21 Student of the Month Award and the Citizenship Award; and

22 WHEREAS, the Exchange Club of Byram gives an annual award to
23 the Police Officer of the Year and to the Fireman of the Year for
24 their fearless service to the community; and

25 WHEREAS, the Exchange Club of Byram recently won the National
26 Service Award for its volunteer work in Americanism, Youth,

27 Community Service and Child Abuse Prevention, and for the club's
28 extraordinary dedication in meeting the challenge to serve the
29 community through these projects; and

30 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Mississippi Senate to
31 commend the exemplary service of its citizens:

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
33 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend the Exchange Club of Byram,
34 Mississippi, upon its one-year anniversary and for its dedicated
35 service to the community.
