SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 17 (As Adopted by Senate)

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING JAMES LAMAR EVANS FOR HIS COURAGEOUS 2 AND HEROIC ACTIONS ON APRIL 3, 1998. 3 WHEREAS, on April 3, 1998, two young girls fell into the frigid and flood-swollen waters of Lake Ferguson; and 4 5 WHEREAS, upon being advised of the situation, James Lamar Evans, a security guard for the Lighthouse Point Casino Security, 6 ran to the water's edge and, upon discovering that there were two 7 victims and an officer in the water, courageously entered into the 8 9 icy and murky waters of Lake Ferguson; and WHEREAS, disregarding the peril to himself, James Lamar Evans 10 11 plunged through the cable-snarled waters to aid Officer Russell 12 Frazier in searching for a victim who had slipped beneath the surface; and 13 WHEREAS, after Officer Frazier pulled the victim to the 14 15 surface, James Lamar Evans helped an exhausted Officer Frazier to 16 shore; and WHEREAS, in a dramatic scene in the stark struggle for life, 17 18 a white hand grasped a black hand and the victim was pulled to 19 safety; and WHEREAS, through the prism of joyful tears, there was no 20 color of skin but a rainbow of compassion, courage and heroism; 21 2.2 and 23 WHEREAS, the Legislature of Mississippi wishes to recognize 24 and thank James Lamar Evans for his daring, courageous, 25 compassionate and heroic actions at the scene of a near tragedy: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MISSISSIPPI STATE 26
