SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 20
(As Adopted by Senate)

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE TUPELO HIGH
2 SCHOOL GOLDEN WAVE BOYS SOCCER TEAM AND HEAD COACH DANNY PORTER
3 FOR WINNING ITS SECOND STRAIGHT CLASS I STATE TITLE AND FOR ITS
4 EXCELLENT 1998-1999 SEASON.

6 outlasted the Clinton Arrows team 2-1 in sudden-death overtime for
7 the state Class I title; and
