## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 65 (As Adopted by Senate)

1 A RESOLUTION TO COMMEND THE MUSEUM OF SOUTHERN JEWISH 2 EXPERIENCE OF UTICA, MISSISSIPPI, AS A RECIPIENT OF THE GOVERNOR'S AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN THE ARTS. 3 4 WHEREAS, the Museum of Southern Jewish Experience of Utica, Mississippi, mounted a special exhibit entitled "Alsace to 5 America" in Jackson; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the Alsace to America exhibit treated thousands of visitors to a new understanding of the rich tradition of Jewish 8 9 life in Mississippi and the South through this artistic presentation of cultural artifacts; and 10 WHEREAS, the private museum in Utica, which interprets, 11 12 documents and preserves the long history of Jewish culture in the 13 South, brought to life the struggles and triumphs of Jews who sought freedom in the American South; and 14 15 WHEREAS, these pioneers from France and Germany, who helped settle towns along the Mississippi River from New Orleans to 16 Memphis, were social, political and cultural leaders in their 17 communities; and 18 WHEREAS, through an extensive collection of artifacts, this 19 20 exhibit chronicled the life of these prosperous communities during the early 1900's; and 21 WHEREAS, a gradual exodus from these rural communities to 22 urban settings left a dwindling Jewish population in these areas; 23 24 and WHEREAS, under the guidance of Macy B. Hart, executive 25 26 director of the museum, the vision for preservation was expressed

30 WHEREAS, superior historical research and exhibit design 31 coupled with the sensitive portrayal of Jewish heritage, artistry, 32 and culture established the Alsace to America exhibit as an 33 enduring legacy of Jewish communities in the South; and
