A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MISSISSIPPI GULF COAST COMMUNITY 1 2 COLLEGE BASKETBALL COACH BOB WEATHERS FOR HIS 800TH WIN. 3 WHEREAS, Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College will honor 4 Head Basketball Coach Bob Weathers for his 800th win with a 5 reception at the Liaison on the Perkinston campus on March 29, 1999; and 6 7 WHEREAS, in the entire 60-year history of the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA), only three other coaches 8 9 have ever reached the lofty plateau of recording 800 victories; 10 and WHEREAS, Weathers' career tally sheet lists an 815 victories 11 against just 306 losses, a mark that includes nine state 12 championships and three trips to Hutchinson, Kansas, for the 13 national tournament -- 1990, 1991, and 1993; and 14 WHEREAS, Bob Weathers began his coaching career as an 15 16 assistant for two seasons at the University of Southern Mississippi, his alma mater, before guiding Picayune High School 17 18 for one season; and 19 WHEREAS, in 1960, then Gulf Coast President Dr. J.J. Hayden, Jr., chose Weathers to lead the Bulldogs' fortunes, and Gulf Coast 20 21 fans have been thankful ever since; and WHEREAS, Bob Weathers entered the National Junior College 22 Athletic Association (NJCAA) Hall of Fame in 1994 and averages an 23 24 astounding 21 wins per season against an average of just five 25 losses; and WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to commend and 26
