REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MR. PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H.B. No. 1588: Appropriation; Public Employees' Retirement System-administrative expenses; maintenance and operation of building.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
8	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
9	Treasury to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of		
10	the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of		
11	defraying the administrative expenses of the Board of Trustees of		
12	the Public Employees' Retirement System, or out of any money in		
13	the State Treasury to the credit of the Retirement System Building		
14	Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose		
15	of maintenance and general operation of the Retirement System		
16	Building, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending		
17	June 30, 2000\$ 7,493,520.00.		
18	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of		
19	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be		
20	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of		
21	expenditure:

41	policies established by the State Personnel Board and any		
42	conditions placed on such expenditures:		
43	(a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan		
44	shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds		
45	appropriated herein.		
46	(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable		
47	Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all		
48	full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous		
49	current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One		
50	Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to		
51	adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand		
52	Dollars (\$1,000.00).		
53	(c) If an employee is currently at or above the end		
54	salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall		
55	be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any		
56	increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a		
57	current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the		
58	effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently		
59	receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above		
60	during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase		
61	effective the date of the rating.		
62	It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds		
63	required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal		

- 64 Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for
- 65 that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the
- 66 agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 68 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 70 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 71 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 72 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 73 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
- 74 allocated in Section 2 in the category "Personal Services:
- 75 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits, "not more than Fifty Thousand
- 76 Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be used to pay overtime compensation
- 77 for work on data processing records after regular office hours.
- 78 SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 79 necessary while remaining within the project cost of Thirteen
- 80 Million Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$13,260,000.00), is
- 81 hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 82 credit of the Administrative Expense Account of the Public
- 83 Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of defraying the
- 84 expenses of implementing the information technology plan know as
- 85 "Genesis", for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending
- 86 June 30, 2000......\$3,000,000.00.
- 87 SECTION 5. Funds are provided in this act for the
- 88 reallocation of an Optimal Imaging Operator to an Administrative
- 89 Assistant III not to exceed One Thousand One Hundred Thirty-nine
- 90 Dollars (\$1,139.00).
- 91 SECTION 6. Funds are provided in this act for the
- 92 reallocation of an Investment Accountant to an Investment Manager
- 93 not to exceed Two Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-nine Dollars
- 94 (\$2,329.00).
- 95 SECTION 7. With the funds provided herein, it is the
- 96 intention of the Legislature that the Board of Trustees of the
- 97 Public Employees' Retirement System study and make recommendations
- 98 to the Mississippi Legislature by January 1, 2000, concerning the

99	feasibility of members of the Pub	lic Employees' Retirement System	
100	electing to increase employees' contributions in order to increase		
101	the annual retirement allowance.		
102	SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by		
103	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the		
104	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon		
105	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal		
106	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the		
107	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.		
108	SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from		
109	and after July 1, 1999.
