REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MR. PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H.B. No. 1624: Appropriation; District Attorneys and staff.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be	
7	necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State	
8	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying	
9	salaries and travel expenses of district attorneys and assistant	
10	district attorneys of the state and paying office expenses of	
11	district attorneys for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and	
12	ending June 30, 2000\$ 12,313,041.00.	
13	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of	
14	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be	
15	expended for the respective purposes:	
16	(a) Salaries and travel expenses of district attorneys,	
17	assistant district attorneys and criminal investigators of the	
18	state:	
19	Salaries\$11,098,386.00	
20	Travel Expenses	
21	Tort Claims Assessment\$ 31,488.00	
22	None of the funds authorized in this section shall be used to	
23	reimburse district attorneys or their staff for taxable meals	
24	incurred within their geographical district.	
25	(b) Office expenses of district attorneys as authorized	
26	by Section 25-31-8, Mississippi Code of 1972	
27	\$ 768,000.00.	
28	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1,	

29	Eighty-five Thousand Ninety-nine Dollars (\$85,099.00) is provided		
30	to fund salary and office expense	for one (1) full-time legal	
31	assistant in the Sixth Circuit Court District as authorized in		
32	Section 25-31-5(2)(f), Mississippi Code of 1972.		
33	SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by		
34	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the		
35	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon		
36	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal		
37	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the		
38	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law		
39	SECTION 5. This act shall ta	ke effect and be in force from	
40	and after July 1, 1999.
