## **REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE**

## **MR. SPEAKER AND MR. PRESIDENT:**

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H.B. No. 1634: Appropriation; Soil and Water Conservation Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be б necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Soil and 8 Water Conservation Commission for the purpose of defraying the 9 administrative expenses of the commission and carrying out the provisions of Section 69-27-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, 10 11 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000 \$ 1,100,987.00. 12

SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 13 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 14 15 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Soil and 16 Water Conservation Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for 17 18 the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 19 20 1,296,274.00. .....\$ SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 21 22 Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below 23 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 24 expenditure: MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 25

(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

(c) If an employee is currently at or above the end
salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall
be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any

Employees who subsequently 66 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 67 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 68 effective the date of the rating.

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission is hereby authorized to retain all funds generated from the sale of equipment. Any funds made available from the sale of equipment shall be deposited into the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission and shall be used solely for the purpose of purchasing equipment.

SECTION 5. The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission is hereby authorized to receive, budget and expend any proceeds derived from the sale of bonds authorized in Section 69-27-331 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. All expenditures shall be in accordance with conditions provided in Section 69-27-331 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

92 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 93 Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall have the authority to 94 escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed 95 Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) in accordance 96 with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 97 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of

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99 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the 100 intention of the Legislature that Fifty-five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00) be used for the purpose of funding a Beaver Control 101 102 Cost Share program. The Mississippi Soil and Water Conservation 103 Commission shall promulgate rules and regulations for the establishment and operation of the program on a fund matching 104 105 basis with the county unit of government. Funds not expended or encumbered in a county may be transferred to another county during 106 107 the fiscal year. Only those funds specifically appropriated for the Beaver Control Cost Share program shall be used in any such 108 109 program.

SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 116 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 117 and after July 1, 1999.
