REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MR. PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H.B. No. 1640: Appropriation; Mississippi Authority for Educational Television.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the policies established by the State Personnel Board and any conditions placed on such expenditures:

48 (a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
49 shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
50 appropriated herein.

(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

(c) If an employee is currently at or above the end salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the

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It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

72 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 73 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

Funds appropriated herein shall first be used for the continuation of a full and complete broadcast schedule of educational and instructional, professional growth, and public service programs, with the production of new films and programs to be secondary thereto.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
Section 2, One Million Six Hundred Forty-four Thousand Sixty-seven
Dollars (\$1,644,067.00) shall be derived from the Education
Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and
27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 5. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall be 88 transferred to, expended by, or used, directly or indirectly, for 89 the benefit of any public relations, publicity or publication 90 91 activities of any other state agency, department or officer, nor shall any personnel paid or equipment purchased with funds 92 93 appropriated hereby be transferred or assigned to any other state agency, department or officer for public relations, publicity or 94 publication activities of such office. 95

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SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 8. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee for Fiscal Year 2001.

SECTION 9. Of the funds provided herein, One Million Five 147 148 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) is provided to the 149 Mississippi Authority for Educational Television to purchase a 150 mobile digital production vehicle. The mobile production vehicle 151 shall be used for many educational purposes which include 152 informing Mississippi citizens of our many and varied work force 153 opportunities. The production vehicle shall also be used to 154 assist the Mississippi Tobacco Pilot Program and for promoting Mississippi natural wildlife, state parks, tourism and economic 155 156 development.

SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 and allocated in Section 3, Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall come from the Mississippi Tobacco Pilot Program as authorized in the case <u>Mike Moore Attorney General ex</u> <u>rel. State of Mississippi v. The American Tobacco Company et al.</u> (Chancery Court of Jackson County, Mississippi, Cause No. <u>94-1429).</u>

164 SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 165 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 166 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 167 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 168 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 169 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

170 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from 171 and after July 1, 1999.
