9	for the commission and department and shall provide legal services	
10	as may be requested. The executive director is authorized to	
11	employ legal counsel, after consultation with the Attorney	
12	General, as may be necessary or appropriate for the operation of	
13	the department. This section shall repeal on July 1, 2000.	
14	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from	
15	and after its passage.
