## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S.B. No. 3151: Appropriation; IHL - MSU -Cooperative Extension Service.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and
8	maintenance of the Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service for
9	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999 and ending June 30, 2000
10	\$ 22,585,523.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
13	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available
14	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi
15	Cooperative Extension Service for the fiscal year beginning
16	July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000
17	\$ 14,062,779.00.
18	SECTION 3. No general funds authorized to be expended herein
19	shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds
20	which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions
21	of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
22	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
23	Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service provide programs in the
24	emphasis areas of Agriculture, Home Economics, 4-H, and Community
25	Resource Development in each county.
26	SECTION 5. No part of the funds appropriated or authorized

to be expended hereby shall be spent directly or indirectly for

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- 28 payment of attorneys' fees for the services of any attorney who
- 29 was not employed by the Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service
- 30 pursuant to the express authorization of the Board of Trustees of
- 31 Institutions of Higher Learning prior to performance of such legal
- 32 services.
- 33 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 34 agency's budget request for fiscal year 2001 shall be submitted to
- 35 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 36 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 37 during the fiscal year 2000 budget request process.
- 38 SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that if the
- 39 funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act are used directly or
- 40 indirectly to match or otherwise secure any federal grants,
- 41 research grants or donations, such special source funds not
- 42 classified as current restricted funds shall be added and
- 43 accounted for under Section 2 of this act. Further, it is the
- 44 intention of the Legislature that all such aforementioned special
- 45 source funds be included in all reports and requests for the 2000
- 46 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature.
- 47 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the
- 48 following amounts shall be derived from the Education Enhancement
- 49 Fund as follows:
- 50 (a) One Million Two Hundred Thirty-six Thousand Nine Hundred
- Forty-three Dollars (\$1,236,943.00) shall be derived
- from funds deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and
- 53 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 54 (b) Two Hundred Ninety Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-
- two Dollars (\$290,572.00) shall be derived from funds
- deposited pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1),
- 57 Mississippi Code of 1972.
- SECTION 9. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
- 59 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
- 60 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
- 61 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
- 62 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
