## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S.B. No. 3153: Appropriation; Alcorn State-Agricultural Programs.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 The following sum, or so much thereof as may be SECTION 1. 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and 8 maintenance of the Alcorn State University Agricultural Programs 9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 10 June 30, 2000.....\$ 4,382,983.00. 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 12 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available, 13 for the support and maintenance of the Alcorn State University 14 15 Agricultural Programs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, 16 and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 2,131,523.00. SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 17 18 following amounts shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund as follows: 19 20 Twenty-two Thousand Two Hundred Seven Dollars (a) (\$22,207.00) shall be derived from funds deposited 21 22 pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi 23 Code of 1972. Two Million Nine Thousand Three Hundred Sixteen Dollars 24 (b) 25 (\$2,009,316.00) shall be derived from funds deposited

pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1), Mississippi Code

of 1972.

19	SECTION 5. No general funds authorized to be expended herein
50	shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds
51	which are being used for salaries which are withdrawn and no
52	longer available.
53	SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
54	agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2001 shall be submitted to
55	the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
56	detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
57	during the Fiscal Year 2000 budget request process.
58	SECTION 7. Should revenues generated and deposited to the
59	Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1),
50	Mississippi Code of 1972, fall below funds appropriated herein

  75 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that of
- the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, the
  amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be
  allocated to defray the cost of a Sweet Potato program in Bolivar
  County.
- SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
  the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
  credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
  warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
  Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
  proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
