1	AMEND by inserting the following immediately after Section 2
2	and by renumbering the succeeding sections:
3	SECTION 3. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is an
4	emergency medical technician certified under Chapter 59 of Title
5	41, Mississippi Code of 1972, upon payment of the road and bridge
6	privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
7	prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
8	trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of
9	an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this
10	section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for each motor
11	vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as an
12	emergency medical technician. The distinctive license tags so
13	issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax
14	Commission, with the advice of the Mississippi Department of
15	Health, Division of Emergency Medical Services, may prescribe and
16	shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be
17	necessary to distinguish each license tag.
18	(2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
19	by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
20	prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for the
21	distinctive license tag shall present proof of their certification
22	as an emergency medical technician to the county tax collector.
23	The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection

- 24 (3) of this section, less five percent (5%) thereof to be retained
- 25 by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax
- 26 Commission within seven (7) days of the date the application is
- 27 made. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax
- 28 collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.
- 29 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
- 30 after July 1, 1999, any person applying for a distinctive license
- 31 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
- 32 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag
- 33 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all
- 34 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a
- 35 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established
- 36 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the
- 37 time the original application is made for a distinctive license
- 38 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of
- 39 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive
- 40 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive
- 41 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax
- 42 collector.
- 43 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
- 44 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
- 45 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the
- 46 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the
- 47 distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State
- 48 Treasurer shall distribute an amount equal to Seven Dollars
- 49 (\$7.00) of the additional fees collected for each such distinctive
- 50 license tag issued under this section to the State General Fund,
- 51 and the remainder of such additional fees collected shall be
- 52 deposited to the credit of the Mississippi Trauma Care Systems
- 53 Fund created under Section 41-59-75.
- 54 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 55 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under

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- 56 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 57 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 58 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 59 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 60 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 61 tag.
- 62 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 63 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 64 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 65 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
- 66 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
- 67 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
- 68 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
- 69 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
- 70 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
- 71 distinctive license tags issued under this section.
- 72 **AMEND FURTHER**, the title, by inserting the following
- 73 immediately after the semicolon on line 9:
- 74 TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS TO CERTIFIED
- 75 EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS; TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION OF THE
- 76 ADDITIONAL FEES COLLECTED FOR SUCH DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS SHALL
- 77 BE DEPOSITED TO THE CREDIT OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRAUMA CARE SYSTEMS
- 78 FUND;
