1	AMEND by inserting the following paragraph after line 1293:
2	Notwithstanding any provision in this paragraph (c) to the
3	contrary, from and after July 1, 1999, any of the twenty-five (25)
4	beds in the DeSoto County facility that are prohibited by this
5	paragraph (c) from participation in the Medicaid program may be
6	certified for participation in the Medicaid program, and claims
7	may be submitted for Medicaid reimbursement for persons in any of
8	those twenty-five (25) beds, if the persons in those beds for
9	which Medicaid reimbursement claims are submitted are Mississippi
10	residents who were being treated in out-of-state psychiatric
11	residential treatment facilities on July 1, 1999, and if it will
12	be less expensive to the Medicaid program, as determined by the
13	Division of Medicaid, for those persons to receive psychiatric
14	residential treatment facility services in those beds in the
15	DeSoto County facility than for the persons to receive such
16	services in out-of-state beds. In addition, from and after July
17	1, 1999, any of those twenty-five (25) beds in the DeSoto County
18	facility may be certified for participation in the Medicaid
19	program, and claims may be submitted for Medicaid reimbursement
20	for persons in any of those twenty-five (25) beds, if the persons
21	in those beds for which Medicaid reimbursement claims are
22	submitted are persons who reside in Mississippi within a one
23	hundred-mile radius of the DeSoto County facility, or are persons

24	who are first placed in psychiatric residential treatment facility
25	services by the youth courts or the Department of Human Services
26	after June 30, 1999, and are placed in the DeSoto County facility,
27	or are persons who are referred by other health care providers to
28	the DeSoto County facility for treatment after June 30, 1999.
29	However, the youth courts and the Department of Human Services
30	shall not place any person who is eligible for Medicaid in any of
31	those twenty-five (25) beds in the DeSoto County facility unless
32	there are no other psychiatric residential treatment facility beds
33	certified for Medicaid reimbursement that are available in
34	Mississippi for such placement on the date that the placement is
35	made, but the youth courts and the Department of Human Services
36	shall consider placing persons who need psychiatric residential
37	treatment facility services and who are eligible for Medicaid in
38	any of those twenty-five (25) beds in the DeSoto County facility
39	before placing the persons in any out-of-state facility. In
40	addition, the DeSoto County facility shall not be authorized to
41	accept any placement by the youth courts or the Department of
42	Human Services of any person who is eligible for Medicaid and who
43	will receive treatment in any of those twenty-five (25) beds, and
44	shall not accept any referral by a health care provider of any
45	person who is eligible for Medicaid and who will receive treatment
46	in any of those twenty-five (25) beds, unless there are no other
47	psychiatric residential treatment facility beds certified for
48	Medicaid reimbursement that are available in Mississippi for such
49	placement or treatment at the time that the person is admitted to
50	the DeSoto County facility. A written or oral representation made
51	by the director or administrator of a psychiatric residential
52	treatment facility to the director or administrator of the DeSoto
53	County facility or his designee that the facility has no
54	psychiatric residential treatment facility beds certified for
55	Medicaid reimbursement that are available at the time of the

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56	representation shall be a sufficient determination by the DeSoto
57	County facility that there are no psychiatric residential
58	treatment facility beds certified for Medicaid reimbursement
59	available at that facility for placement or treatment at the time
60	a person is admitted to the DeSoto County facility, if the
61	representation is recorded and maintained in writing by the DeSoto
62	County facility and the person is admitted to the DeSoto County
63	facility within five (5) days after the representation is made.
64	The provisions of this paragraph regarding participation in the
65	Medicaid program for any of those twenty-five (25) beds in the
66	DeSoto County facility shall be fully binding on any subsequent
67	owner of the DeSoto County facility if the ownership of the
68	facility is transferred at any time after July 1, 1999.

70	AMEND FURTHER the title on line 9 by inserting the following
71	after the semicolon:
72	TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN BEDS AT A PSYCHIATRIC RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT
73	FACILITY IN DESOTO COUNTY TO BE CERTIFIED FOR PARTICIPATION IN

MEDICAID UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS;

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
