Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

11	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
13	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Fair Commission's
14	special fund account, to the Mississippi Fair Commission for the
15	purposes of defraying the costs of prizes, premiums, judges and
16	other actual and necessary costs of putting on the Dixie National
17	Livestock Show at the State Fairgrounds in Jackson, Mississippi,
18	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending
19	June 30, 2000\$ 904,800.00.
20	SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be
21	necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
22	General Fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi Fair
23	Commission as follows:
24	(a) For the support of annual roundup shows for junior
25	exhibitors of junior steers, junior breeding cattle, beef cattle,
26	dairy cattle, hogs, sheep and poultry, for the fiscal year
27	beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000
28	\$ 60,484.00.
29	(b) To supplement the funds paid by the Mississippi Fair
30	Commission for livestock premiums at the State Fair, all livestock
31	premiums to be paid on the American system of judging (1st. 2nd.

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3rd, 4th, etc.) on all classes entered in the senior division for
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   the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.

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            (c) For the county livestock shows in offering and
   paying prizes or awards to competitors in the approved county
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   livestock shows of Mississippi, for the fiscal year beginning July
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   1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....$ 15,838.00.
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        Provided, however, that of the amount herein appropriated in
   subsection (c), not more than One Thousand Dollars ($1,000.00)
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   shall be expended or used in any one county of the state during
   each fiscal year. Provided, further, that none of the moneys
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   herein appropriated in subsection (c) shall be used in offering or
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   paying prizes or awards for any livestock show that is not held
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   where there are adequate barns, pens and other facilities
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   available for such a show.
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        Provided further, in subsection (c) that the management of
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   such shows shall be in the hands of a county livestock
   association, and such association shall guarantee a minimum amount
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   of Five Hundred Dollars ($500.00) to be used in the paying of
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   prizes, premiums or awards, and after said county show has been
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   held and premiums paid, fifty percent (50%) of the amount, not
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   exceeding One Thousand Dollars ($1,000.00), shall be paid upon
   requisition to the Mississippi Fair Commission.
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        Provided further, in subsection (c) that in any county which
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   has two (2) shows with proper facilities, and a contiguous county
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   has no such fair and desires to participate in a fair to be held
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   in an adjoining county, each of the two (2) fairs in one county
   may receive an equal proportion of the funds hereby appropriated,
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   provided, both shows shall not receive an aggregate sum of more
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   than One Thousand Dollars ($1,000.00).
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            (d) For the purpose of offering awards and prizes to
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   competitors in the five (5) district livestock shows, for the
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3 4	riscal year beginning outy 1, 1999, and ending oune 30, 2000

66	(e) For the purpose of offering awards and prizes to
67	competitors in the five (5) state dairy shows as provided in
68	Section 69-5-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal

71	Provided further, that no part of the money herein
72	appropriated under the provisions of subsections (d) and (e) shall
73	be used for any other purpose than to pay premium awards at said
74	shows and state shows and expositions receiving legislative
75	appropriation shall not conflict in dates in order that livestock
76	exhibitors may make the circuit of shows. Provided further, that
77	none of the above mentioned funds shall be paid to any district
78	shows unless shows are held prior to roundup.
79	Not less than seventy-five percent (75%) of the funds herein
80	appropriated under the provisions of subsections (d) and (e) shall
81	be used in awarding prizes or premiums to 4-H Club members and
82	Smith-Hughes School members and other boys and girls having
83	entries in said shows.
84	All funds herein appropriated under the provisions of
85	subsections (d) and (e) for the five (5) district livestock shows
86	and the five (5) Fall state dairy shows shall be distributed in
87	such manner that the livestock exhibitors will each draw equal
88	premium awards for comparable grades and placings at each of the
89	said five (5) district Spring shows and the five (5) Fall state
90	shows. The management of each district Spring show and each state
91	Fall show shall submit to the Mississippi Fair Commission, within
92	fifteen (15) days after the close of each said show, a full report
93	on the number of exhibitors at each said show, with the grades and
94	placings of the different classes of livestock exhibited.
95	The Executive Secretary of the Mississippi Fair Commission,

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96	together with a committee of three (3) to be named by the
97	President of the Mississippi Livestock Council from that
98	organization, shall summarize and prepare a unified list of awards
99	for like classes in all Spring district livestock shows and Fall
100	state dairy shows receiving state premium money, as authorized in
101	subsections (d) and (e). The Executive Secretary and Chairman of
102	the Mississippi Fair Commission shall approve and present a
103	requisition to the State Fiscal Officer for the payment of the
104	amount of funds in subsections (d) and (e) due each show and said
105	State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrant thereon, and it shall
106	be paid by the State Treasurer.
107	Provided, however, as a condition of expenditure of the funds
108	appropriated in subsections (d) and (e), that the board of
109	directors of any district livestock show may, in its discretion,
110	choose to hold its show in the Fall instead of the Spring. If
111	district shows are held in both Spring and Fall, then all funds
112	herein appropriated for the five (5) district livestock shows
113	shall be distributed in such a manner that the Spring livestock
114	exhibitors will each draw equal premium awards for comparable
115	grades and placings at each district Spring show, and the Fall
116	livestock exhibitors will each draw equal premium awards for
117	comparable grades and placings at each district Fall show.
118	(f) For promotion and expenses of the winners of the
119	Mississippi High School Rodeo for attending the national finals,
120	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending
121	June 30, 2000\$ 9,899.00
122	(g) For the promotion and expenses of the seafood rodeo
123	in Biloxi known as the Shrimp Festival, for the fiscal year
124	beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000

126	SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
127	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

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credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 1999.

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
