# Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and
8	maintenance of the Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service for
9	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999 and ending June 30, 2000
10	\$ 20,861,322.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
13	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available
14	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi
15	Cooperative Extension Service for the fiscal year beginning July
16	1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000
17	\$ 13,162,779.00.
18	SECTION 3. No general funds authorized to be expended herein
19	shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds
20	which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions
21	of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
22	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
23	Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service provide programs in the
24	emphasis areas of Agriculture, Home Economics, 4-H, and Community
25	Resource Development in each county.

No part of the funds appropriated or authorized to be expended hereby shall be spent directly or indirectly for payment of attorneys' fees for the services of any attorney who was not employed by the Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service pursuant to the express authorization of the Board of Trustees of Institutions of Higher Learning prior to performance of such legal services.

33 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 34 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2001 shall be submitted to 35 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 36 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 37 during the Fiscal Year 2000 budget request process.

38 SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that if the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act are used directly or 39 40 indirectly to match or otherwise secure any federal grants, research grants or donations, such special source funds not 41 42 classified as current restricted funds shall be added and 43 accounted for under Section 2 of this act. Further, it is the intention of the Legislature that all such aforementioned special 44 45 source funds be included in all reports and requests for the 2000 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature. 46

47 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 48 following amounts shall be derived from the Education Enhancement 49 Fund as follows:

50 (a) One Million Two Hundred Thirty-six Thousand Nine Hundred
51 Forty-three Dollars (\$1,236,943.00) shall be derived
52 from funds deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and
53 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

54 (b) Two Hundred Ninety Thousand Five Hundred Seventy55 two Dollars (\$290,572.00) shall be derived from funds

91 SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that of 92 the funds appropriated in Section 1 and authorized for expenditure 93 in Section 2, Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be 94 allocated to defray the costs of the Northeast Mississippi Swine 95 Demonstration Unit located at the Pontotoc Branch Experiment 96 Station.

97 SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that of
98 the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, an
99 Extension Beef Specialist position shall be funded.

100 SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that of 101 the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, an Area 102 Aquaculture Agent for East Central Mississippi shall be funded.

SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that of the funds authorized for expenditures in Section 2, One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be allocated to defray the costs of the International Livestock Program at Mississippi State University.

SECTION 15. Should revenues generated and deposited to the Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1), Mississippi Code of 1972, fall below funds appropriated herein from said source, the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning shall notify the Department of Finance and Administration as to which allotments shall be reduced to insure that expenditures do not exceed actual revenues.

SECTION 16. In addition to all other funds heretofore appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby allocated out of any money deposited in the State Treasury from the Mississippi Tobacco Pilot Program as authorized in the case <u>Mike Moore Attorney General ex rel. State</u> <u>of Mississippi v. The American Tobacco Company et al. (Chancery</u> <u>Court of Jackson County, Mississippi, Cause No. 94-1429)</u> to the

125 SECTION 17. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 126 of Section 1, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) shall be 127 allocated to defray the costs of a Production Economist at the 128 Delta Research and Extension Center at Stoneville, Mississippi.

129 SECTION 18. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 130 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 131 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 132 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 133 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 134 SECTION 19. This act shall take effect and be in force from 135 and after July 1, 1999. 136
