30 (a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
31 shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds

(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all
full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous
current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One
Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to
adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand
Dollars (\$1,000.00).

40 (c) If an employee is currently at or above the end salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall 41 42 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any 43 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the 44 45 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 46 47 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase effective the date of the rating. 48

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

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58 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 59 amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall 60 be provided from the Motor Carrier Regulation Account to defray 61 the expenses of the Department of Economic and Community 62 Development in operating the state welcome centers.

63 SECTION 5. The acceptance and expenditure of funds, and interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or 64 65 other orders of or agreements involving any agency, instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or the United 66 67 States for petroleum price compliance and allocation which may 68 become available during the fiscal year for the support of the Department of Economic and Community Development or any programs 69 70 sponsored under the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby authorized not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and 71 72 approved, provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and 73 otherwise accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 et 74 seq., and Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of Economic and Community Development is hereby authorized to escalate and expend funds from any source not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

82 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of Economic and Community Development shall maintain 83 84 complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 85 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 86 87 maintained for Fiscal Year 1999. It is further the intention of 88 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 89 2001 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee

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90 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 91 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2000 budget request 92 process.

93 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the amount of Nine Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars 94 95 (\$9,200,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism 96 Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2000. The expenditure 97 of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section 98 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972. 99

100 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the amount of Two Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars 101 (\$2,200,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 102 provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and 103 104 facilitating Mississippi business growth for Fiscal Year 2000. The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be 105 106 exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

107 SECTION 10. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 108 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 109 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 110 intended mission of this agency. The funds herein 159 160 appropriated shall be held separate and apart from all other funds appropriated to the Department of Economic and Community 161 162 Development.

SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 163 164 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 165 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 166 167 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 168 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from 169 and after July 1, 1999. 170

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
