- 96 Section 2, funds are included to defray the costs of clothing for
- 97 sworn law enforcement officers in an amount not to exceed One
- 98 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) annually per officer.
- 99 SECTION 6. Funds are provided in this act to reallocate one
- 100 (1) Public Information Officer to Public Relations Director at an
- 101 annualized cost not to exceed Eleven Thousand One Hundred
- 102 Forty-three Dollars (\$11,143.00), and one (1) BN-Intelligence
- 103 Analyst to BN-Intelligence Analyst Senior at an annualized cost

- 106 SECTION 7. In addition to the salary increases provided in
