Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTION 37-61-9.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE A PUBLIC HEARING AND ADVERTISEMENT OF PROPOSED INCREASES IN LOCAL AD VALOREM TAX EFFORT OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE FORM OF SUCH NOTICE; TO REPEAL SECTION 27-39-207, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE ADVERTISEMENT OF INTENTION TO INCREASE THE AD VALOREM TAX EFFORT OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

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
