Pending AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill NO. 1082

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 18 SECTION 1. Section 39-5-23, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 19 amended as follows:
- 20 39-5-23. (1) The Mississippi Department of Archives and
- 21 History is hereby authorized and empowered to solicit and accept
- 22 donations, bequests, devises, gifts and grants of money from
- 23 individuals, organizations and federal, state and local
- 24 governmental bodies, to be deposited in the Historic Properties
- 25 Trust Fund which is hereby created in the State Treasury.
- 26 Contributions to the Historic Properties Trust Fund may be
- 27 undesignated or earmarked for the purpose of acquiring,
- 28 preserving, restoring, supporting, operating and administering
- 29 <u>Mississippi Landmark properties or for</u> use on specific <u>historical</u>
- 30 projects that have been authorized by the Department of Archives
- 31 and History. The State Treasurer shall invest all monies in the
- 32 Historic Properties Trust Fund as other state funds are authorized
- 33 to be invested, and any interest earned shall be deposited into
- 34 the fund. * * *
- 35 (2) The Mississippi Department of Archives and History is
- 36 hereby authorized and empowered to solicit and accept donations,
- 37 bequests, devises, gifts and grants of money and real and personal
- 38 property. The Board of Trustees of the Department of Archives and

- 39 History may, in its discretion, sell such real and personal
- 40 property by public or private sale and shall deposit proceeds
- 41 derived from such sale into the Historic Properties Trust Fund.
- 42 (3) (a) The Board of Trustees of the Mississippi Department
- 43 of Archives and History is authorized to establish the Mississippi
- 44 Landmark Grant Program within the Historic Properties Trust Fund
- 45 to help ensure the preservation of Mississippi Landmark
- 46 properties.
- 47 <u>(b) The Board of Trustees of the Mississippi Department</u>
- 48 of Archives and History may deposit funds appropriated by the
- 49 Legislature, or funds transferred from the Historic Properties
- 50 Financing Fund as specified in Section 89-12-37(2), into the
- 51 <u>account established for the Mississippi Landmark Grant Program</u>
- 52 within the Historic Properties Trust Fund. All funds deposited in
- 53 the account for the Mississippi Landmark Grant Program shall be
- 54 <u>used exclusively for the purpose of acquiring, preserving,</u>
- 55 <u>restoring</u>, <u>supporting</u>, <u>operating</u> <u>and</u> <u>administering</u> <u>Mississippi</u>
- 56 Landmark properties or those properties to be designated as
- 57 <u>Mississippi Landmarks.</u>
- 58 <u>(c) The board of supervisors of every county and the</u>
- 59 governing authorities of every municipality in the state may make
- 60 contributions to the Mississippi Department of Archives and
- 61 <u>History</u>, to be deposited into the account for the Mississippi
- 62 Landmark Grant Program. Such contributions may be undesignated or
- 63 <u>earmarked for use on specific Mississippi Landmark properties.</u>
- (d) The Board of Trustees of the Mississippi Department
- 65 of Archives and History shall have all powers necessary to
- 66 implement and administer the Mississippi Landmark Grant Program,
- 67 and the board of trustees shall promulgate all rules and
- 68 regulations necessary for the implementation and administration of
- 69 the program.
- 70 SECTION 2. Section 89-12-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 71 amended as follows:

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89-12-37. (1) All funds received under the provisions of
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    this chapter shall forthwith be deposited by the treasurer in a
    special fund hereby established in the State Treasury to be
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    designated the "Abandoned Property Fund," except that the
    treasurer shall deposit in a separate special fund hereby
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    established in the State Treasury to be designated the "Abandoned
    Property Claims Payment Fund" an amount not exceeding One Hundred
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    Fifty Thousand Dollars ($150,000.00) from which he shall make
    prompt payment of claims duly allowed by him as hereinafter
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    provided. Before making the deposits in either special fund, he
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    shall record the name and last known address of each person
    appearing from the holders' reports to be entitled to the
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    abandoned property and the name and last known address of each
    insured person or annuitant and, with respect to each policy or
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    contract listed in the report of a life insurance corporation, its
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    number, the name of the corporation and the amount due.
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    record shall be available for public inspection at all reasonable
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    business hours.
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         (2) There is created within the Abandoned Property Fund in
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    the State Treasury a trust to be known as the Historic Properties
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    Financing Fund, which shall be used as provided in this section.
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    On July 1, 1999, Ten Million Dollars ($10,000,000.00) in the
    Abandoned Property Fund shall be set aside and placed in the
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    Historic Properties Financing Fund created herein. The principal
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    of the Historic Property Financing Fund shall remain inviolate
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    within the Abandoned Property Fund, and shall be invested in the
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    same manner as the remainder of the Abandoned Property Fund. The
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    interest and income earned from the investment of the principal of
    the Historic Properties Financing Fund shall be transferred
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    quarterly to the Mississippi Landmark Grant Program account within
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    the Historic Properties Trust Fund created under Section 39-5-23.
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    The transferred money shall be utilized by the Department of
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    Archives and History for the purposes as specified in Section
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 $105 \quad 39-5-23(3)$.

106 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 107 and after July 1, 1999.
