33	It is the intent of the Legislature that any state funds made
34	available for salaries of licensed personnel in excess of the
35	funds paid for such salaries for the 1986-1987 school year shall
36	be paid to licensed personnel pursuant to a personnel appraisal
37	and compensation system implemented by the State Board of
38	Education. The State Board of Education shall have the authority
39	to adopt and amend rules and regulations as are necessary to
40	establish, administer and maintain the system.

- 77 (2) Prior to April 15 of any school year in which a teacher meets the standard requirements, any licensed teacher who shall 78 have met the requirements and acquired a Master Teacher 79 80 certificate from the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards and who is employed by a local school board or the State 81 Board of Education as a teacher and not as an administrator shall 82 receive a salary supplement in the amount of Six Thousand Dollars 83 84 (\$6,000.00) in addition to any other compensation to which the 85 teacher may be entitled. AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-19-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE FOR A SALARY SUPPLEMENT AND PROCESS REIMBURSEMENT FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT COUNSELORS WHO HAVE OBTAINED THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR CERTIFIED COUNSELORS' ENDORSEMENT AS A NATIONAL CERTIFIED SCHOOL COUNSELOR; TO PROVIDE FOR A SALARY SUPPLEMENT FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGISTS AND AUDIOLOGISTS WHO OBTAIN THE CERTIFICATE OF CLINICAL COMPETENCE FROM THE AMERICAN SPEECH-LANGUAGE-HEARING ASSOCIATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
