AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill NO. 1339

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 SECTION 1. Section 63-5-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7 amended as follows:

8 63-5-13. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
9 the total outside width of any vehicle, exclusive of required
10 safety devices, or the load thereon shall not exceed eight and
11 one-half (8-1/2) feet.

12 (2) The total outside load width of any vehicle hauling
13 unprocessed forest products on public roads, streets or highways,
14 other than interstate highways, shall not exceed nine and one-half
15 (9-1/2) feet if such products may not be shortened without
16 rendering them useless for the end product for which they were
17 cut; provided, however, the total outside vehicle width of such a
18 vehicle, exclusive of required safety devices and the load of such
19 vehicle, shall not exceed eight and one-half (8-1/2) feet.

20 (3) The total outside width of a farm tractor shall not
21 exceed ten (10) feet, except that farm tractors shall not be
22 operated upon the interstate highways without a special permit
23 from the State Highway Commission.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
25 and after its passage.

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-5-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 AUTHORIZE VEHICLES HAULING CERTAIN UNPROCESSED FOREST PRODUCTS TO
3 HAVE A TOTAL OUTSIDE LOAD WIDTH OF NOT MORE THAN 9-1/2 FEET; AND
4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
