## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

51	current performance	rating below "meets expectations" as of the	
52	effective date of t	he increase. Employees who subsequently	
53	receive a performan	ce rating of "meets expectations" or above	
54	during Fiscal Year	2000 shall receive the salary increase	
55	effective the date	of the rating.	
56	It is the agen	cy's responsibility to make certain that funds	
57	required to be appr	opriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal	
58	Year 2001 do not ex	ceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for	

that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the

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- 60 agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 64 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 65 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 66 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 67 SECTION 3. Funds are provided in this act for the
- 68 reallocation of a Nursing Home Administrator Board Licensing
- 69 Official to an Executive Director not to exceed Seven Thousand
- 70 Three Hundred Sixty-eight Dollars (\$7,368.00).
- 71 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 72 Mississippi State Board of Nursing Home Administrators deposit all
- 73 revenue generated into a special fund in the State Treasury to the
- 74 credit of the Mississippi State Board of Nursing Home
- 75 Administrators and that all interest earned or deposited to the
- 76 fund shall remain in the fund and not be paid into the State
- 77 General Fund of Mississippi.
- 78 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 79 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 80 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 81 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 82 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 83 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 84 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 85 and after July 1, 1999.
