- 74 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 75 Public Service Commission shall have the authority to escalate and
- 76 expend funds from any proceeds arising from participation in drug
- 77 seizure activities not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 78 (\$50,000.00), in accordance with the rules and regulations of the
- 79 Department of Finance and Administration.
- SECTION 5. Funds are provided in this act to defray the cost
- 81 of reallocating PIN 66 from Administrative Assistant V to
- 82 Administrative Assistant VII.
- 83 SECTION 6. With the funds herein appropriated, the Public
- 84 Service Commission may implement, through the State Personnel
- 85 Board, a reorganization of the Regulated Carrier Enforcement
- 86 Division using the same guidelines that were used to restructure
- 87 the Weight Enforcement Division of the Mississippi Department of
- 88 Transportation authorized in fiscal year 1999.
- 89 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 90 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 91 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

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- 92 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 93 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 94 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 95 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 96 and after July 1, 1999.
