full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous
current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One
Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to
adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand
Dollars (\$1,000.00).

(c) If an employee is currently at or above the end 73 74 salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall 75 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any 76 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a 77 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the 78 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently 79 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above 80 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase effective the date of the rating. 81

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

87 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 88 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 6. Of the funds provided herein, Six Million Six Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$6,630,000.00) is provided to match federal funds for the State Child Health Insurance Program (SCHIP).

118 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 119 Sections 1, 2 and 3, funds shall be used to pay the state matching 120 portion of the costs of Medicaid Eligibility Workers at the 121 Department of Human Services.

SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
