12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
14	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
15	Library Commission which is comprised of special source funds
16	collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the
17	purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal
18	year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000
19	\$ 2,712,696.00.
20	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
22	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
23	expenditure:

45	Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be
46	expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the
47	policies established by the State Personnel Board and any
48	conditions placed on such expenditures:
49	(a) The components of the Variable Compensation Plan
50	shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds
51	appropriated herein.
52	(b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable
53	Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all
54	full-time employees with at least six (6) months of continuous
55	current service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One
56	Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to
57	adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand
58	Dollars (\$1,000.00).

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- (c) If an employee is currently at or above the end
- 60 salary for his or her job classification, then the increase shall
- 61 be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any
- 62 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a
- 63 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the
- 64 effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently
- 65 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above
- 66 during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase
- 67 effective the date of the rating.
- It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds
- 69 required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal
- 70 Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for
- 71 that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the
- 72 agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

- 78 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 79 Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems
- 80 under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid
- 81 quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March

- 83 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 84 Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred
- 85 Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the
- 86 Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75
- 87 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 88 SECTION 5. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
- 89 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
- 90 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
- 91 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the

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92 intended mission of this agency. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Library Commission shall have the authority to 117 118 escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and 119 120 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 121 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. SECTION 7. With the funds provided herein, Thirty-one 122 123 Thousand Dollars (\$31,000.00) is provided to the Mississippi

Library Commission to purchase one (1) passenger/cargo van.

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SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law
SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 1999.
