142 SECTION 2. Section 37-3-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
 143 amended as follows:

144 37-3-9. (1) * * * From and after July 1, 1984, there shall
 145 be a State Superintendent of Public Education who shall be
 146 appointed by the State Board of Education, with the advice and
 147 consent of the Senate, and serve at the board's will and pleasure.

148 He shall be the chief administrative officer for the State
 149 Department of Education and shall administer the department in
 150 accordance with the policies established by the State Board of
 151 Education. He shall receive such compensation in the amount
 152 prescribed by the State Board of Education, but not to exceed the
 153 salary of the Commissioner of Higher Education. The State
 154 Superintendent of Public Education shall have at least a master's
 155 degree in any field and a minimum of five (5) years' experience in
 156 administration in the educational field.

157 (2) The state superintendent shall give bond in the penalty
 158 of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00), with sureties to be
 159 approved by the Governor, conditioned according to law. Said bond
 160 when approved shall be filed and recorded in the office of the
 161 Secretary of State.

162 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
163 and after July 1, 1999.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 REVISE THE SALARY OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE PEARL RIVER
3 VALLEY WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT; TO AMEND SECTION 37-3-9, MISSISSIPPI
4 CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF
5 EDUCATION SHALL RECEIVE AN ANNUAL SALARY PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE
6 BOARD OF EDUCATION, BUT NOT TO EXCEED THE SALARY OF THE
7 COMMISSIONER OF HIGHER LEARNING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
