## \*\*\*Pending\*\*\* AMENDMENT No. 1 PROPOSED TO

Committee Sub. for SB NO. 2856

# Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. The President of the Senate and the Speaker of 9 the House of Representatives shall each appoint three (3) members 10 of their respective legislative houses to serve as members of the 11 Mississippi Technology, Inc., Liaison Committee. The members of 12 such committee shall be entitled (a) to attend meetings of the 13 Mississippi Technology, Inc., Board of Directors, (b) to receive 14 all budgets, reports, audits and all financial and other 15 16 information distributed to the directors of Mississippi Technology, Inc., (c) to meet and confer with the directors and 17 staff of Mississippi Technology, Inc., and (d) to perform such 18 other activities as may be necessary or proper in discharging 19 their responsibilities of liaison with their respective houses of 20 the Legislature. The members of the liaison committee shall have 21 no jurisdiction or vote on any matter within the jurisdiction of 22 23 Mississippi Technology, Inc. The members of the committee shall prepare and submit an annual report to the Legislature no later 24 than December 15 of each calendar year setting forth the 25 26 activities and financial condition of Mississippi Technology, 27 Inc., and their perspective and comments on the activities of 28 Mississippi Technology, Inc. The report shall also contain recommendations regarding policy or legislative changes for 29

consideration by the Legislature. The members of the Mississippi 30 31 Technology, Inc., Liaison Committee shall be bound by the same 32 limitations as to confidentiality of information regarding products, processes or the internal affairs of private businesses, 33 as are imposed upon the officers and directors of Mississippi 34 35 Technology, Inc. When the Legislature is not in session, members shall be paid per diem and all actual and necessary expenses, 36 37 including mileage expenses, from their respective contingent expense funds at the rate authorized for committee meetings when 38 39 the Legislature is not in session; however, no per diem and expenses will be paid when the Legislature is in session. The 40 terms of the members of the liaison committee shall expire at the 41 42 end of their terms of office.

43 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 44 and after July 1, 1999.

#### Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and

#### inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE MISSISSIPPI TECHNOLOGY, INC., LIAISON 2 COMMITTEE TO BE COMPOSED OF THREE MEMBERS OF THE SENATE AND THREE 3 MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES; TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH 4 COMMITTEE ATTEND MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE 5 MISSISSIPPI TECHNOLOGY, INC., TO SERVE AS A LIAISON BETWEEN 6 MISSISSIPPI TECHNOLOGY, INC., AND THE LEGISLATURE; AND FOR RELATED 7 PURPOSES.

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
