(d) A person acting under color of law <u>who</u> intercepts a wire, oral or other communication if the person is a party to the communication, or if one of the parties to the communication has given prior consent to the interception; or

29 (e) A person not acting under color of law who intercepts a wire, oral or other communication if the person is a 30 party to the communication, or if one of the parties to the 31 communication has given prior consent to the interception unless 32 the communication is intercepted for the purpose of committing any 33 34 criminal or tortious act in violation of the Constitution or laws 35 of the United States or of this state, or for the purpose of committing any other injurious act. 36
