3	SECTION *. Section 37-9-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
4	amended as follows:
5	37-9-17. On or before April 1 of each year, the principal of
б	each school shall recommend to the superintendent of the school
7	district the licensed employees or noninstructional employees to
8	be employed for the school involved except those licensed
9	employees or noninstructional employees who have been previously
10	employed and who have a contract valid for the ensuing scholastic
11	year. If such recommendations meet with the approval of the
12	superintendent, the superintendent shall recommend the employment
13	of such licensed employees or noninstructional employees to the
14	school board, and, unless good reason to the contrary exists, the
15	board shall elect the employees so recommended. If, for any
16	reason, the school board shall decline to elect any employee so
17	recommended, additional recommendations for the places to be
18	filled shall be made by the principal to the superintendent and
19	then by the superintendent to the school board as provided above.
20	The school board of any school district shall be authorized to
21	designate a personnel supervisor or another principal employed by
22	the school district to recommend to the superintendent licensed
23	employees or noninstructional employees; however, this

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24 authorization shall be restricted to no more than two (2) 25 positions for each employment period for each school in the school 26 district, and provided further that any noninstructional employee 27 employed under this authorization shall have been employed by the school district at the time such superintendent takes office and 28 29 no noninstructional employee employed under this authorization 30 shall receive compensation in excess of the statewide average compensation for such noninstructional position with comparable 31 experience, as developed by the State Department of Education. 32 33 The school board of any school district shall be authorized to 34 designate a personnel supervisor or another principal employed by the school district to accept the recommendations of principals or 35 36 their designees for licensed employees or noninstructional 37 employees and to transmit approved recommendations to the board; however, this authorization shall be restricted to no more than 38 two (2) positions for each employment period for each school in 39 40 the school district.

When the licensed employees have been elected as provided in the preceding paragraph, the superintendent of the district shall enter into a contract with such persons in the manner provided in this chapter.

If, at the commencement of the scholastic year, any licensed 45 employee shall present to the superintendent a license of a higher 46 47 grade than that specified in such individual's contract, such 48 individual may, if funds are available from minimum education program funds of the district, or from district funds, be paid 49 50 from such funds the amount to which such higher grade license would have entitled the individual, had the license been held at 51 52 the time the contract was executed.
