- 8 SECTION 1. Section 19-3-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 19-3-39. (1) The members of the board of supervisors are 10
- conservators of the peace within their respective counties, and 11
- shall possess all the powers as such which belong to, or are 12
- 13 conferred on, justice court judges.
- 14 (2) The board of supervisors of any county, by a majority
- vote, may find in contempt any person who violates any order of 15
- 16 the board duly adopted and entered on its minutes and may impose a
- fine in such amount as it may establish for such violations. Any 17
- such fine so imposed may be enforced by entering the fine on the 18
- judgment roll of the county, and such fine, when so ordered, shall 19
- 20 be a lien on all of the real and personal property of the
- 21 contemnor until he purges himself thereof.
