## HOUSE BILL NO. 23

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS 2 COSTING ONE MILLION DOLLARS OR MORE SHALL BE FUNDED BY THE 3 LEGISLATURE IN THREE PHASES; TO DEFINE EACH PHASE; TO PROVIDE THAT 4 EACH PHASE SHALL BE FUNDED IN SEPARATE REGULAR SESSIONS OF THE LEGISLATURE; TO EXEMPT CERTAIN PROJECTS FROM SUCH REQUIREMENTS; TO 5 REQUIRE ALL STATE AGENCIES WHICH PLAN TO UNDERTAKE A CAPITAL 6 IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT TO SUBMIT A PREPLANNED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS 7 8 PROJECT PROJECTION TO THE BUREAU OF BUILDING, GROUNDS AND REAL PROPERTY MANAGEMENT FOR EVALUATION; TO PROVIDE THAT ANY PROJECT 9 COSTING UNDER ONE MILLION DOLLARS SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO BE 10 PREPLANNED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

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13 SECTION 1. Every capital improvements project, costing One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or more, which is developed to 14 repair, renovate, construct, remodel, add to or improve a state-15 owned public building shall be funded by the Legislature in three 16 (3) phases. The three-phase funding requirement shall not apply 17 to capital improvements projects for a state-owned port or where 18 the Legislature finds that an emergency or critical need must be 19 met or a court order complied with. The three (3) phases shall 20 21 not be funded in the same regular session of the Legislature. 22 Each phase shall be funded in a separate regular session of the Legislature. Phase 1 shall be a preplanned capital improvements 23

project budget projection for the project and shall be funded

first. Phase 2 shall be the actual repair, renovation,

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- 26 construction, remodeling, addition to or improvement of the state-
- 27 owned public building and shall be funded second. Phase 3, if
- 28 necessary, shall be the acquisition of furniture and equipment for
- 29 the capital improvements project and shall be funded last.
- 30 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) For the purposes of this act, the term
- 31 "preplanned" or "preplanning" means the preliminary planning that
- 32 establishes the program, scope, design and budget for a capital
- 33 improvements project.
- 34 (2) Every state agency that plans to repair, renovate,
- 35 construct, remodel, add to or improve a state-owned public
- 36 building shall submit a preplanned capital improvements project
- 37 budget projection to the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real
- 38 Property Management for evaluation. The bureau shall assess the
- 39 need for all preplanned projects submitted and shall compile a
- 40 report on its findings. Any capital improvements project costing
- 41 under One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall not be required to
- 42 be preplanned.
- 43 (3) Upon the completion of any preplanning for a capital
- 44 improvements project, if such preplanning is funded with
- 45 self-generated funds by a state agency, the plan shall be
- 46 submitted to the bureau for evaluation.
- 47 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 48 and after July 1, 2000.
