HOUSE BILL NO. 36

AN ACT TO DIRECT ALL STATE AGENCIES, DEPARTMENTS AND 1 2 INSTITUTIONS SUBMITTING BUDGET REQUESTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR TO DEVELOP THOSE BUDGET REQUESTS 3 4 PURSUANT TO ZERO-BASED BUDGETING; TO DIRECT THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE AND THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE TO DEVELOP BUDGET 5 RECOMMENDATIONS PURSUANT TO ZERO-BASED BUDGETING; TO REQUIRE THAT 6 EACH APPROPRIATION BILL ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE BE DETERMINED 7 PURSUANT TO ZERO-BASED BUDGETING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Each state agency, department or institution that 11 is required to submit a budget request for fiscal year 2002 and 12 for each subsequent fiscal year shall develop the request pursuant 13 to zero-based budgeting to the extent that each budgetary unit 14 shall:

(a) Upon identifying the component programs and
describing the activities conducted by each program, specify the
legal basis for each program of the budgetary unit to conduct each
activity described;

(b) Itemize in detail by object of expenditure the budgetary requirements for conducting the activities of each program for the prior fiscal year actual expenditures, current fiscal year estimated expenditures and budget fiscal year projected expenditures by starting with a base of zero dollars and adding dollar amounts for activities conducted in the prior fiscal

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(c) Identify and itemize in detail by object of
expenditure the changes in the budgetary requirements for
conducting the activities of each program between the prior fiscal
year actual expenditures and the current fiscal year estimated
expenditures, and between the current fiscal year estimated
expenditures and the budget fiscal year projected expenditures;

Develop a narrative for each program justifying 33 (d) each line-item of the itemized budgetary requirements for 34 conducting the activities of the program for the prior fiscal year 35 actual expenditures, and justifying each line-item of the itemized 36 37 changes in the budgetary requirements for conducting the 38 activities of the program between the prior fiscal year actual expenditures and the current fiscal year estimated expenditures, 39 40 and between the current fiscal year estimated expenditures and the budget fiscal year projected expenditures. 41

SECTION 2. The Joint Legislative Budget Committee and the 42 Governor's Office shall review and evaluate only those budget 43 requests developed as prescribed in paragraphs (a) through (d) of 44 45 Section 1, and develop budget recommendations to the Legislature starting with a base of zero dollars for each program in each 46 47 budgetary unit and adding dollars as necessary for actual expenditures on activities approved in the prior fiscal year, and 48 adding or reducing dollars as necessary for estimated changes in 49 expenditures approved for the current fiscal year, and adding or 50 51 reducing dollars as necessary for recommended changes in the expenditures deemed appropriate for the budget fiscal year. 52

53 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The Legislature shall determine each 54 appropriation for fiscal year 2002 and each subsequent fiscal year 55 for expenditure by any state agency, department or institution by

No. 36 00\HR07\R154 PAGE 2 56 starting with a base of zero dollars for each program in each 57 budgetary unit and adding dollars as necessary for actual 58 expenditures on activities approved in the prior fiscal year, and 59 adding or reducing dollars as necessary for estimated changes in 60 expenditures approved for the current fiscal year, and adding or 61 reducing dollars as necessary for changes in expenditures deemed 62 appropriate for the budget fiscal year.

63 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 64 and after July 1, 2000.

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
