HOUSE BILL NO. 50

AN ACT TO REQUIRE CERTAIN INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP HEALTH 1 INSURANCE POLICIES AND PLANS TO OFFER COVERAGE FOR MEDICALLY 2 NECESSARY FORMULAS FOR THE TREATMENT OF INHERITED DISEASES OF 3 4 AMINO ACID, ORGANIC ACID, CARBOHYDRATE OR FAT METABOLISM, AND MALABSORPTION ORIGINATING FROM CONGENITAL DEFECTS; TO PROVIDE THAT 5 COVERAGE FOR INHERITED DISEASES OF AMINO ACIDS AND ORGANIC ACIDS 6 SHALL INCLUDE FOOD PRODUCTS MODIFIED TO BE LOW PROTEIN; TO PROVIDE 7 THAT THIS ACT APPLIES NOTWITHSTANDING THE EXISTENCE OF ANY 8 PREEXISTING CONDITION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 SECTION 1. (1) Each individual or group health insurance 11 12 policy, contract, certificate or plan, pooled risk health insurance policy or plan, or any type of managed or capitated 13 14 health care plan or policy that is regulated by the State of Mississippi, which is issued, issued for delivery, renewed, 15 continued or executed in this state after June 30, 2000, shall 16 make available as part of the application, coverage for 17 prescription and nonprescription enteral formulas for home use 18 19 that are prescribed by a physician as medically necessary for the treatment of inherited diseases of amino acid, organic acid, 20 carbohydrate or fat metabolism, as well as malabsorption 21 originating from congenital defects present at birth or acquired 22 during the neonatal period. Coverage for inherited diseases of 23 amino acids and organic acids shall include food products modified 24

(2) This section applies to any person or familynotwithstanding the existence of any preexisting condition.

(3) This section does not apply to policies, contracts or
plans that provide coverage only for accidents or specified
diseases.

31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 32 and after July 1, 2000.

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
