HOUSE BILL NO. 77

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-48, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF	1972,
---	-------

- TO PROVIDE THAT THE ADDITIONAL FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A
- 3 PERSONALIZED LICENSE TAG SHALL BE DUE AND PAYABLE UPON ORIGINAL
- 4 APPLICATION FOR A PERSONALIZED LICENSE TAG AND THEREAFTER ONLY
- 5 UPON THE FIRST RENEWAL REGISTRATION FOLLOWING THE ISSUANCE OF NEW
- 6 LICENSE TAGS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 27-19-48, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 27-19-48. (1) Owners of motor vehicles who are residents of
- 11 this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to
- 12 registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment of
- 13 the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and
- 14 registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of
- 15 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles,
- 16 and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in
- 17 subsection (4)(a) of this section, shall be issued a personalized
- 18 license tag of the same color as regular license tags to consist
- 19 of the name of the county and not more than seven (7) letters of
- 20 the alphabet or seven (7) numbers in lieu of the license tag
- 21 numbering system prescribed by law. The purchaser of the
- 22 personalized license tag may choose the combination of such
- 23 letters or numbers, but no two (2) motor vehicles shall have the

24 same combination of letters or numbers. In the event that the

25 same combination of letters has been chosen by two (2) or more

26 purchasers, the State Tax Commission shall assign a different

27 number to each such purchaser which shall appear on the license

28 tag following the combination of letters; provided, however, this

29 combination shall not exceed seven (7) letters and/or numbers.

30 The combination of letters and/or numbers written across the

31 license tag shall be sufficiently large to be easily read but

32 shall not be less than three (3) inches in height. No combination

33 of letters or numbers which comprise words or expressions that are

34 considered obscene, slandering, insulting or vulgar in ordinary

35 usage shall be permitted, with the Chairman of the State Tax

36 Commission having the responsibility of making such determination.

37 If, however, such license plate is issued in error or otherwise

38 and is determined by the chairman to be obscene, slanderous,

39 insulting, vulgar or offensive, the chairman shall notify such

40 owner that the license plate must be surrendered and that another

41 personalized license plate may be selected by him and issued at no

42 cost. Should the vehicle owner not desire another personalized

43 license plate, the fee for such plate shall be refunded. In the

44 event the owner fails to surrender the license plate after

45 receiving proper notification, the chairman shall issue an order

46 directing that the license plate be seized by agents of the State

47 Tax Commission or any other duly authorized law enforcement

48 personnel. If such owner is aggrieved by this determination, the

49 appeal procedure and the provisions provided in Section 27-19-337

50 shall be followed.

51 (2) For the purposes of this section the terms "motor

52 vehicle" and "vehicle" include motorcycles.

53 (3) Application for the personalized license tags shall be

54 made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State

55 Tax Commission. The application form shall contain space for the applicant to make five (5) different choices for the combination 56 57 of the letters and numbers in the order in which said combination is desired by the applicant. The application and the additional 58 fee, less five percent (5%) thereof to be retained by the tax 59 collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission within 60 seven (7) days of the date the application is made. The portion 61 of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be 62 deposited into the county general fund. 63

Beginning with any registration year commencing on

or after November 1, 1986, any person applying for a personalized 65 license tag shall pay an additional fee which shall be in addition 66 to all other taxes and fees. The <u>license tag</u> shall be <u>valid</u> for a 67 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 68 license tag year. The additional fee of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) 69 is due and payable at the time the original application is made 70 71 for a personalized tag. Thereafter, for as long as the owner 72 retains the personalized tag, the additional fee is not again due and payable except upon the first renewal registration following 73 issuance of new license tags under Section 27-19-31. If at any 74 time the owner does not wish to retain such personalized tag, he 75 must surrender it to the local county tax collector. 76 77 additional fee due * * * shall be collected by the county tax 78 collector and remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly 79 basis as prescribed by the commission.

80 (b) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all taxes
81 and fees into the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end
82 of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify the total

- 83 fees collected under this section to the State Treasurer who shall
- 84 distribute to the credit of the State General Fund Sixteen Dollars
- 85 and Twenty-five Cents (\$16.25) of each additional fee and the
- 86 remainder of each such additional fee shall be deposited to the
- 87 credit of the State Highway Fund to be expended solely for the
- 88 repair, maintenance, construction or reconstruction of highways.
- 89 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 90 required by law until replaced by a personalized license tag; and
- 91 the regular license tag must be surrendered to the tax collector
- 92 upon issuance of the personalized license tag. The tax collector
- 93 shall issue up to two (2) license decals for the personalized
- 94 license tag, which will expire the same month and year as the
- 95 original license tag.
- 96 (6) The applicant shall receive a refund of the fee paid for
- 97 a personalized license tag if the personalized license tag is not
- 98 issued to him because the combination of letters and numbers
- 99 requested to be placed thereon is not available for any reason.
- 100 (7) In the case of loss or theft of a personalized license
- 101 tag, the owner may make application and affidavit for a
- 102 replacement license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee
- 103 for a replacement personalized license tag shall be Ten Dollars
- 104 (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving such application and
- 105 affidavit shall be entitled to retain and deposit into the county
- 106 general fund five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement
- 107 license tag and the remainder shall be distributed in the same
- 108 manner as funds from the sale of regular license tags.
- 109 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 110 and after July 1, 2000.
