## HOUSE BILL NO. 86

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11-35-61, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO REVISE THE COMPENSATION OF A GARNISHEE; AND FOR RELATED
- 3 PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11-35-61, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 11-35-61. The garnishee shall be allowed for his attendance,
- 8 out of the debts or effects in his possession, or against the
- 9 plaintiff in attachment, judgment, or decree in case there be no
- 10 debts or effects in his possession, provided he shall put in his
- 11 answer within the time prescribed by law, the pay and mileage of a
- 12 juror, and, in exceptional cases rendering it proper, the court
- 13 <u>shall</u> allow the garnishee reasonable compensation additional to
- 14 the foregoing and to be obtained in the same way which shall be
- 15 <u>not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Seventy-five</u>
- 16 <u>Dollars (\$75.00)</u>.
- 17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2000.
