REMOVE THE EXEMPTION UNDER THE MISSISSIPPI MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-13-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO

3 INSPECTION LAW OF THOSE MOTOR VEHICLES MANUFACTURED OR HAVING A 4 MODEL YEAR EARLIER THAN 1961; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 63-13-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 63-13-7. (1) * * * The Commissioner of Public Safety shall, 8 not more than once each year, require that every motor vehicle, 9 trailer, semitrailer and pole trailer registered in this state be 10 inspected and that an official certificate of inspection and 11 approval be obtained for each such vehicle. Each such vehicle 12 must display at all times a certificate of inspection and approval 13 duly issued for such vehicle upon the lower left hand corner of 14 the windshield thereof or upon such vehicle in such position as to 15 be visible from the outside. 16 (2) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section, 17 every motor vehicle registered in any other state and operated 18 over the highways of this state shall be inspected and shall 19 display an inspection certificate which shall be different either 20 21 in color or design from the inspection certificates issued for use

22 on state registered vehicles.

However, the Commissioner of Public Safety may authorize the 23 acceptance in this state of a certificate of inspection and 24 approval issued under the authority of a qualified agency or 25 26 department of another state, provided that every municipality, county and state office in such other state accepts under a 27 mutually acceptable reciprocal agreement, Mississippi's 28 certificate of inspection and approval. The commissioner shall 29 except from the provisions of this chapter all passenger buses and 30 other vehicles certified by the Interstate Commerce Commission and 31 subject to its rules and regulations and its periodical 32 inspections. 33

34 (3) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall require all
35 school buses in the State of Mississippi to be inspected during
36 the months of July or August each year and may provide such
37 special certificate of inspection and approval as he may deem
38 necessary.

40 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 41 and after July 1, 2000.
