## HOUSE BILL NO. 96

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-3-603, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REQUIRE VEHICLES TO BE DRIVEN IN THE RIGHT-HAND LANE ON 2 3 ROADWAYS DIVIDED INTO FOUR OR MORE LANES FOR TRAFFIC; AND FOR 4 RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 63-3-603, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 63-3-603. Whenever any roadway has been divided into three 8 (3) or more clearly marked lanes for traffic, except through or 9 bypassing a municipality, the following rules in addition to all 10 others consistent herewith shall apply: 11 12 (a) A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practical entirely within a single lane and shall not be moved from such 13 lane until the driver has first ascertained that such movement can 14 be made with safety. 15 (b) A vehicle shall not be driven in the center lane 16 upon a roadway which is divided into three (3) lanes except when: 17 (i) Overtaking and passing another vehicle where 18 the roadway is clearly visible and such center lane is clear of 19 traffic within a safe distance; 20 21 (ii) Such vehicle is in preparation for a left 22 turn; or

exclusively to traffic moving in the direction such vehicle is
proceeding and is signposted to give notice of such allocation.

(c) Official signs may be erected directing slow-moving
traffic to use a designated lane or allocating specified lanes to
traffic moving in the same direction, and drivers of vehicles
shall obey the directions of every such sign.

(d) Upon all roadways any vehicle proceeding at less 30 than the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under 31 the conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand 32 lane then available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the 33 right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except when overtaking and 34 passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or when 35 36 preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a private road or driveway. 37

(e) <u>Whenever any roadway is divided into four (4) or</u>
more lanes for traffic, every vehicle shall be driven in the
right-hand lane nearest the edge of the roadway except when
overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same
direction or except when preparing for a left turn or exit to the
<u>left.</u>

44 (f) Persons riding bicycles upon a roadway shall not 45 ride more than two (2) abreast except on paths or parts of 46 roadways set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles. Persons 47 riding two (2) abreast shall not impede the normal and reasonable 48 movement of traffic and, on a laned roadway, shall ride within a 49 single lane.

50 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 51 and after July 1, 2000.

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
