HOUSE BILL NO. 118

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES  
2 AND HISTORY FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESTORING BEULAH CEMETERY IN  
3 VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2001.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be  
6 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General  
7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Archives and  
8 History for the purpose of restoring Beulah Cemetery in Vicksburg,  
9 Mississippi, which is a historic landmark that was established in  
10 1884 and is on the National Register of Historic Places, for the  
11 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30,  
12 2001 . . . . . \$100,000.00.

13 SECTION 2. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid  
14 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund  
15 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State  
16 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his  
17 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or  
18 officers in the manner provided by law.

19 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
20 and after July 1, 2000.
