HOUSE BILL NO. 146

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 55-13-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REVISE THE EXEMPTIONS FOR BUILDINGS LOCATED ADJACENT TO THE 3 NATCHEZ TRACE PARKWAY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 55-13-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 55-13-35. It shall be unlawful to construct or erect a building of more than three (3) stories or thirty-five (35) feet 8 9 in height, whichever is lesser, within one thousand (1,000) feet 10 of the outside boundary of the Natchez Trace Parkway. Such restrictions on buildings shall apply notwithstanding that such 11 12 area is located inside or outside a municipality and 13 notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary. It is the legislative intent of this section, in part, that 14 possession of a building permit on July 1, 1988, shall not allow 15 any construction after July 1, 1988, based on that permit. This 16 section shall not apply to any building in existence on July 1, 17 1988. Silos and buildings designed for agricultural use, * * * 18 churches, and schools are exempted from the application of this 19 20 section.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 22 and after July 1, 2000.
