## HOUSE BILL NO. 284

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 83-1-153, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2	TO EXCLUDE CERTAIN RELIGIOUS PUBLICATIONS FROM THE JURISDICTION OF
3	THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 83-1-153, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 83-1-153. <u>(1)</u> The provisions of Sections 83-1-151 through
- 8 83-1-169 shall apply to:
- 9 (a) All domestic insurers, and
- 10 (b) Any other insurer doing business in this state
- 11 whose state of domicile has asked the commissioner to apply the
- 12 provisions of Sections 83-1-151 through 83-1-169 to such insurer.
- 13 (2) The provisions of Sections 83-1-151 through 83-1-169
- 14 shall not apply to a religious publication, or its subscribers,
- 15 <u>that:</u>
- 16 <u>(a) Is a nonprofit religious organization;</u>
- 17 (b) Is limited to subscribers who are members of the
- 18 <u>same denomination or religion;</u>
- 19 <u>(c) Acts as an organizational clearinghouse for</u>
- 20 <u>information between subscribers who have financial, physical or</u>
- 21 <u>medical needs and subscribers who choose to assist with those</u>

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- 23 <u>subscribers with a present financial or medical need;</u>
- 24 <u>(d) Pays for the subscriber's financial or medical</u>
- 25 needs by payments directly from one (1) subscriber to another; and
- (e) Suggests amounts to give that are voluntary among
- 27 the subscribers, with no assumption of risk or promise to pay
- 28 <u>either among the subscribers or between the subscribers and the</u>
- 29 <u>publication</u>.
- 30 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 31 and after July 1, 2000.
