AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 39-5-71, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCLUDE THE NAMES OF CERTAIN FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS ON THE LAW ENFORCEMENT MONUMENT AND TO ALLOW THE MONIES PLACED IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS MONUMENT FUND TO BE USED FOR CERTAIN FUND-RAISING PURPOSES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 39-5-71, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

9 39-5-71. (1) The Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards 10 and Training, in cooperation with the Department of Archives and History and the Bureau of Buildings, Grounds and Real Property 11 Management, is hereby authorized, subject to funds being made 12 available, to cause to be constructed and maintained on 13 state-owned lands at some suitable and appropriate place in or 14 near the City of Jackson, a monument containing the names and 15 paying tribute to all state, county and municipal law enforcement 16 17 officers who * * * have given their lives in the performance of their official duties * * *. This shall include any federal law 18 19 enforcement officer employed and residing in Mississippi at the 20 time of death.

It is the intent of the Legislature that adequate space be left on the monument to be available to add names of law

The Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and 25 (2) 26 Training is hereby authorized to accept gifts, grants and donations from individuals and organizations, to be deposited in 27 the Law Enforcement Officers Monument Fund which is hereby created 28 29 as a special fund in the State Treasury. The State Treasurer shall invest all monies in the fund and any interest earned shall 30 be deposited into the fund. All funds deposited in the fund, 31 including interest earned thereon, shall be used * * * for the 32 purpose of <u>fund-raising</u>, erecting and maintaining the monument as 33 provided in subsection (1) of this section. The funds may be used 34 35 for any fund-raising activity the board deems necessary for the 36 construction and maintenance of the monument. Any monies remaining unexpended or unencumbered in the fund upon completion 37 38 of the monument shall revert to the Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Training for maintenance of the monument. 39 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 40 and after July 1, 2000. 41
