HOUSE BILL NO. 390

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT DECEPTIVE PACKAGING RELATING TO STAMPING 2 PACKAGES OF CIGARETTES; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; AND 3 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) It shall be unlawful to affix a Mississippi 6 revenue stamp, including any local municipal or county stamp, to 7 or upon any package of cigarettes or to sell or hold for sale any 8 package of cigarettes to which a Mississippi revenue stamp, including any local municipal or county stamp, has been affixed 9 10 if:

(a) The package differs in any respect with the requirements of the Federal Cigarette Labeling and Advertising Act, 15 USCS 1331 et seq., for the placement of labels, warnings, or any other information upon a package of cigarettes that is to be sold within the United States;

16 (b) The package is labeled "For Export Only," "United 17 States Tax Exempt," "For Use Outside United States," or similar 18 wording indicating that the manufacturer did not intend that the 19 product be sold in the United States;

20 (c) The package, or a package containing individually
21 stamped packages, has been altered by adding or deleting the

23 (d) The package has been imported into the United
24 States after January 1, 2000, in violation of 26 USCS 5754; or
25 (e) The package in any way violates federal trademark
26 of copyright laws.

(2) Any person who violates this section shall be fined not 27 more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not 28 more than one (1) year, or both. In addition to such fine and 29 imprisonment, a person who violates this section is subject to the 30 revocation of any license or permit pertaining to the sale of 31 cigarettes or other tobacco products and to the seizure and 32 destruction or sale of any cigarettes by law enforcement officers 33 34 as provided by law.

35 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after July 1, 2000.
