HOUSE BILL NO. 462 (As Passed the House)

- 1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE WOLF RIVER AS A STATE SCENIC STREAM AND TO INCLUDE THAT PORTION IN THE STATE SCENIC STREAMS STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 3

- 5 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
- 6 51-4-23, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 51-4-23. The Wolf River in Pearl River, Hancock, Stone and
- Harrison Counties from Highway 26 in Pearl River County to the Bay 8
- 9 of St. Louis in Harrison County, which was initially designated as
- eligible for inclusion in the scenic stream program under Section 10
- 51-4-17, is designated as a state scenic stream and is included in 11
- 12 the State Scenic Streams Stewardship Program.
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 14 and after its passage.
