HOUSE BILL NO. 473

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARION COUNTY
2 TO CONTRIBUTE A SUM ANNUALLY TO THE CITY OF COLUMBIA FOR THE
3 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING COSTS INCURRED BY THE CITY IN CONTROLLING THE
4 RUNNING AT LARGE OF SMALL ANIMALS AND IN PROVIDING SHELTER, FOOD
5 AND CARE FOR SUCH ANIMALS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of Marion County, in its
8 discretion, may contribute out of any available funds of the
9 county, a sum not to exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00)
10 annually to the City of Columbia, or to the Humane Society or to
11 any other similar organization domiciled in the City of Columbia,
12 for the purpose of defraying costs incurred by the city or by any
13 such organization in controlling the running at large of dogs and
14 other similar small animals and in providing shelter, food and
15 care for such animals.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
17 and after its passage.
