HOUSE BILL NO. 473

- 1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARION COUNTY TO CONTRIBUTE A SUM ANNUALLY TO THE CITY OF COLUMBIA FOR THE
- 3 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING COSTS INCURRED BY THE CITY IN CONTROLLING THE
- RUNNING AT LARGE OF SMALL ANIMALS AND IN PROVIDING SHELTER, FOOD

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of Marion County, in its
- discretion, may contribute out of any available funds of the
- county, a sum not to exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) 9
- 10 annually to the City of Columbia, or to the Humane Society or to
- 11 any other similar organization domiciled in the City of Columbia,
- for the purpose of defraying costs incurred by the city or by any 12
- 13 such organization in controlling the running at large of dogs and
- other similar small animals and in providing shelter, food and 14
- 15 care for such animals.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 16
- 17 and after its passage.
