HOUSE BILL NO. 475

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-41-81, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARDS TO PROVIDE CARDIOPULMONARY 3 RESUSCITATION (CPR) TRAINING TO SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS; TO AMEND 4 SECTION 37-41-83, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE SCHOOL 5 BOARDS TO EXPEND TRANSPORTATION FUNDS FOR CPR TRAINING; AND FOR 6 RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 37-41-81, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:[LH1]

10 37-41-81. The local school boards of this state are * * * authorized and empowered: to purchase, own and operate, under 11 such rules and regulations as may be prescribed by the State Board 12 13 of Education, motor vehicles and other equipment for the 14 transportation of children to and from the public schools of the 15 respective counties and school districts; to provide for the 16 servicing, repair, care and maintenance of such county or district-owned motor vehicles; to employ drivers for the operation 17 thereof and to provide training to such drivers in cardiopulmonary 18 19 resuscitation (CPR) through the American Red Cross or another 20 nationally recognized course in CPR; and to establish, erect and 21 equip school bus shops or garages, and purchase land therefor, all 22 under such rules and regulations as may be prescribed by the State Board of Education. 23

37-41-83. The school boards are authorized and empowered to 26 27 expend the necessary amounts from the available transportation funds of the school district for the purchase of such 28 transportation equipment, the servicing, repair and maintenance 29 thereof, for the payment of the salaries and cardiopulmonary 30 resuscitation (CPR) training of persons employed to drive or 31 operate such transportation equipment, and to establish, erect and 32 33 equip school bus shops or garages, and purchase land therefor. 34 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2000. 35
