HOUSE BILL NO. 481 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE MUNICIPAL CRIME PREVENTION FUND; TO 1 2 PROVIDE THAT THE FUND SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF 3 PUBLIC SAFETY; TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DISTRIBUTE 4 MONIES FROM THE FUND TO EACH MUNICIPALITY IN THE STATE; TO SPECIFY 5 THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH MUNICIPALITIES MAY EXPEND THE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE DEPARTMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. There is created within the State Treasury a 8 9 special fund to be known as the Municipal Crime Prevention Fund. The Department of Public Safety shall distribute monies out of the 10 11 fund to each municipality in this state on a per capita basis, using the population figures from the most recent federal 12 13 decennial census; however, no municipality shall receive less than 14 Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) from the fund. Funds received by municipalities under this section may be expended for, without 15 limitation, any of the following purposes: 16 17 (a) Law enforcement; Equipment, technology, supplies, contractual 18 (b) services, including training and related travel, and commodities; 19 20 (C) State or federal crime prevention grant matching 21 requirements; and Any crime prevention programs implemented by more 22 (d) 23 than one (1) jurisdiction, which may include the State of Mississippi and any of its agencies, departments or political 2.4 subdivisions, through the use of interlocal cooperation 25 26 agreements. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 27 2.8 and after its passage.

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
